





Looking for a quick knit? This easy, SoCal inspired infinity scarf is a must have for the cooler temperatures ahead. Whether you're out on a chilly evening or making a snowman during the day, you will love the classic look of this scarf.

## <u>Materials</u>

- 300-400 yards worsted weight yarn (suggested yarn: Malabrigo worsted weight)
- Size 13 needles
- Tapestry Needle
- Scrap yarn (for provisional cast on)

## <u>Gauge</u>

12 stitches and 14 rows = 4 inches

in stockinette stitch

## **Directions**

- Cast on 32 stitches (For a seamless scarf, use a provisional cast-on)
- Using stockinette stitch, knit until scarf is 60 inches long (or desired length) ending on a knit row
- Bind-off if not using a provisional cast-on
- Graft or seam ends together (be careful not to twist)
- Weave in ends
- Block lightly as needed.

Note: I did not block the scarf at all. The lightly rolled in edge is part of the "look"
